Transitional Kindergarten at Twin Rivers Unified School District

What is Transitional Kindergarten (TK)?

A bridge between preschool and Kindergarten, Transitional Kindergarten (TK) prepares students to develop fundamental skills needed for educational success. Created by the Kindergarten Readiness Act of 2010, Transitional Kindergarten is the first year of a two-year Kindergarten program.

Who qualifies for Transitional Kindergarten (TK)?

California has expanded Transitional Kindergarten programming for students in recent years.

- **For the 24-25 School Year**, students are eligible for TK if they turn 5 between September 2, 2024 and June 2, 2025.
- **For the 25-26 School Year and years following**, all students who turn 4 on or by September 1st can enroll in TK.

How do I enroll my child into Transitional Kindergarten (TK)?

Twin Rivers Unified uses an online enrollment application process where you can enroll for the current school year, or pre-enroll for the next school year.
