

Getting familiar with your Chromebook

To power on the Chromebook, open the lid. If it doesn't power on try pressing the power button on the top right corner of the keyboard. If you have a 3189 Chromebook model, the power is on the right side of the Chromebook. To determine what kind of Chromebook you have, the model can be found on the bottom of the Chromebook.













Connecting your Chromebook To a Wireless Network

When you power on your Chromebook for the first time at home, a message will pop up on your screen: **Network not available**. Below the message there will be a list of available wireless networks.

If you have a wireless internet connection at home, your wireless network name will show up on the list.

1. Click on your wireless network name and a window will pop up.
2. Under the **Password** field, put in your wireless internet connection password.
3. Then click **Connect**
4. It will take a few seconds to connect.
5. Once it's connected you will be redirected to a login in screen.
6. Type in your **Student ID** and click **Next**.
7. Type in your **Password** click **Next**.
8. Give it about a minute to load your desktop and apps.
9. You are now ready to use your Chromebook.

Chromebook Keyboard top row keys

-  Locks the Chromebook (**Only on model 3189**)
-  Power Button (**Only on models 5190, 3100, 3180, 3120**)
-  Go to the previous page in your browser history
-  Go to the next page in your browser history
-  Reload your current page
-  Hide the tabs and launcher in full-screen Immersive mode
-  Show all windows in Overview mode
-  Dim the screen
-  Make the screen brighter
-  Mute
-  Lower the volume
-  Raise the volume



Safety tips:

- Do not share your computer password with anyone.
- Do not close your Chromebook with anything inside of it.
- Do not put anything on top of your Chromebook.
- Do not eat or drink on your Chromebook.
