Current Credential Programs

- Multiple Subject
- Single Subject
- **Education Specialist**
 - Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)
 - Mild/Moderate Support Needs (MMSN)
 - Extensive Support Needs (ESN)

Education Specialist

Two Pathways

- 1 Year Teacher Residency
 - Get \$38,000 in scholarship to pay for tuition, books, etc. and support in applying for additional grants up to \$20,000
- 2 year Working/Intern
 - Keep your job in a classroom or program relevant to credential (paraprofessional or emergency permit teacher)

Adding Credentials

- ✓ Single Subject Math or Science Credential
- ✓ Career Technical Education (CTE) Credential
- ✓ Single Subject Theatre or Dance Credential

Add a Single Subject Math or Science

- Take and pass a single subject methods course
 - Offered in spring and/or summer 2024 (online)
- Take and pass the CSET (free)
- 100% reimbursement of course registration fee (and application fee) upon passing
- Apply to add credential through Sac State



Career Technical Education (CTE)

- If already credentialed, just 1 course needed to add the CTE credential (offered spring)
- For career changers, only 3 courses to earn the credential (starting Fall 2024)
- 100% reimbursement of course registration fee (and application fee) upon passing
- Apply to add credential through Sac State



Single Subject in Theatre or Dance

- If you hold a multiple or single subject teaching credential and want to add a **single subject credential in Theatre or Dance**, we may be offering the course this summer and/or next Fall.
- Ask your district to use Prop 28 funds to pay for course registration

- PK-3 Credential
- Ed Specialist in Deaf/Hard of Hearing
- Single Subject in American Sign Language (ASL)
- Application cycle Oct. 1, 2024- Feb. 1, 2025
