PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF PROPOSED SPECIAL EDUCATION LOCAL PLAN, BUDGET PLAN AND SERVICE PLAN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to Government Code 3547.5 and AB 1200, the Board of Trustees of the Twin Rivers Unified School District (“District”) will hold a public hearing and provide a period for review of documents related to disclosure of the proposed Special Education Local Plan, Budget Plan and Service Plan.

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act 20 United States Code (20 USC) Section 1400 et seq. and related federal regulations, require each special education local plan area (SELPA) to ensure a continuum of program options are available to meet the needs of students with disabilities for special education and related services. Each SELPA must develop a Local Plan outlining policies for providing special education services in compliance with state and federal requirements.

Staff presented information at the February 11, 2020 Board Meeting regarding new legislation that was passed and became effective in June of 2019. Under AB 1808 Local Plan Special Education Local Plan Area, the California Department of Education (CDE) has establish guidelines for the coordinated development and submission of the local plan’s components. Beginning July 1, 2020, all SELPAs are required to submit a local plan using CDE-adopted templates. Section D: Annual Budget and Section E: Annual Services plan are being submitted for Public Hearing.

The Public Hearing will be held on June 18, 2024, at 6:00 PM
