ELA (+3%), Math, and Science are showing improvement from last year. We are higher than the district average in all areas.</p> <p>ELA and Math – want to focus on improvement for students with disabilities. RSP/CurSupport Teachers will be co-teaching next school year.</p> <p>Want to improve communication home to families and offer more support to students and families.</p> <p>Goal 2: Ensure Students Graduate College and Career Ready</p> <p>Dual enrollment - will offer 27 different ARC courses next school year</p>

		<p>Pushed more freshmen into intro ARC class to expose them.</p> <p>More money to be used for different online programs to support this goal.</p> <p>Students want to have more presentations from different trades/careers, not just college.</p> <p>Goal 3: Improve Culture and Climate through increased Student Engagement</p> <p>Sat with Leadership and mapped out different events we want to celebrate and focus on each month.</p> <p>Want to increase student attendance at extracurricular activities. Want to get more students involved.</p> <p>Students want to get more involved in community events such as the RL Light Parade.</p> <p>Lates and tardies are one of the biggest issues on campus. Struggling to figure out what we can do to support students in getting to class on time.</p> <p>Want to get sports teams on campus to attend other teams' games. Athletes supporting athletes.</p> <p>Goal 4: Increase parent engagement through technology, orientations, and other events on campus</p> <p>Goal 5: Facilities that are clean, safe, and conducive to learning and supply materials needed to keep the school operational.</p>
