Work permits will be issued to students who provide proof of enrollment in an educational program and satisfactory grades and attendance. If proper documents are provided: Completed Intent to Employ form, student ID and a copy of the parent's ID that signed the form.

Work permits are required for students under the age of 18, unless students can provide proof of High School Graduation or have a Certificate of Proficiency.
